## Detail of CIL expenditure

Project name and location:

1. To make swings safe
2. To dredge the village pond and make it safe and tidy. This also encouraged natural drainage to alleviate flooding in that area by the public house. To make safe a couple of areas for Health and Safety with new posts and fence.

Brief description of works undertaken:

1. To dig up old matting under the swings and dig out ready to relay new safety matting under all swings. Remove spoil and make tidy with grass seed.

2. To road culvert inlets clear silt trap fabricate new grids and install. To roadside grating lift old grating, clean out silt, rod drain and install new grate with hinged access. At bottom of Watery Lane clear silt and grade back to provide adequate depth to drain inlets.

At three points adjacent to pond and head of Watery Lane, supply and install concrete posts to replace old broken posts, cut rails, straighten and weld joints. SAFETY ISSUE

Supply machinery to excavate and clear pond silt and roadside ditch by garden wall, load into tractor and trailer and haul to tip site on local land.

To footpath in Watery Lane, grade edge install concrete filled sand bags to form new edge. At two points in Watery Lane footpath install french drain to connect water draining from adjoining land under wall, grade pathway to infill adjacent to sand bags and install type I stone and top with shingle as required.
